



THE KENNEL CLUB INTERNATIONAL AGILITY FESTIVAL THURSDAY 10TH AUGUST – SUNDAY 13TH AUGUST



To ensure that you and everyone else attending the show enjoy the experience we request that you follow the guidelines below:

GENERAL

A 5 mph speed limit will be enforced throughout the show ground

CARAVAN AND TENTS

There will be no admittance to the camp site before 9.00am Wednesday, and after 9:00pm. You will be allocated an area 10m x 8m for your caravan, awning and vehicle. All camping pitches have been allocated in advance. Please park where directed, and ensure that all your vehicles are within the area allocated. All roadways must be kept clear at **all** times. The site has to be cleared by 10:00am on Monday.

Your envelope is your camping pass. Please have your envelope to hand at the booking in gate. You will be given a wrist band which we would request you wear throughout the show for security reasons. Children under the age of 10 will be provided with a paper wrist band so that parents can write their mobile number on in case they get lost. Please show your camping pass/envelope when you arrive and leave it in the front window of your vehicle for the duration of the show.

BBQs are not permitted at the venue. All units must have a fire extinguisher and/or bucket of water readily available by the unit.

GENERATORS

Please note that the use of petrol or diesel generators by private individuals will be allowed, with the following conditions:

- Only suitcase type/completely enclosed generators are permitted on the venue, **NO** open frame generators.
- Time restrictions will be in place for all campers, generators can only be used between 5-7pm. Andrew Dicker will be ensuring that all campers comply with these conditions, his contact number is 07768 424535.

Please note trade stands with generators will have a different time restriction of 9am - 5pm each day.

RESULTS

Please note that we will be using an online results system called e-gility for rings 3, 4 and 14. You can access the results through the online mobile app mobile.egility.org

DAY PARKING

Please park in the area indicated, and do not bring your vehicle into the Camping or Ring areas.

DURING THE SHOW

Please note that the road between the rings and trade stands will be closed during competition hours. If you wish to exit the show, then you can do this via the roadway on the hedge line.

SECURITY and EMERGENCIES

There will be security on site throughout the show. All competitors and their families will be required to wear a wrist band at all times, these will be distributed on arrival. Should you need the hospital or veterinary details these will be available on a board next to the secretary's tent and there will be printed directions for you to take, should you need to, from the secretary's tent. If there is an emergency during the Festival and you need to contact a member of the organising committee out of hours please call 07874 379183.

CATERING

Our caterer is Eleanor's Pantry and will be open 07.30am every day from Thursday (12pm on Wednesday) and competitors will be able to order a cooked evening meal daily for collection at a specified time in the evening, Eleanor's pantry will be open until 8pm each evening except Friday Disco night which will be 10pm. This year we have a Beer Bus which will be open daily. We will also be **recycling** cardboard, jars, bottles and cans in a dedicated skip.



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RING AREA

No bicycles will be allowed in the ring area.

LHO & FH CLASSES

Competitors must compete in the height option entered. There will only be one course walking at the start of the class. Each class will start at full height and then go down to the lower height jumps.

MEASURING

There will be measuring at 5pm Wednesday, 10am Thursday, 5pm Thursday and 5pm on Friday. Please register in advance at the Secretary's Marquee.

DOGS

Please ensure that your dogs are under control at all times, and on a lead except when competing in the ring, or in the marked exercise area. All dogs must be on a lead in the camping area. In the marked exercise area each handler is requested to have no more than 2 dogs off lead at any time.

You are reminded of your obligations to your dogs' wellbeing whilst at the show, especially in hot weather. The car and caravan parks will be patrolled, and action taken to release any dog that may be in danger of suffering.

If your dog is tethered at the car or caravan, please ensure that the area around the dog is fenced, to prevent the dog coming into contact with other passing dogs or people.

Please pick up after your dog **and put bags into the receptacles provided.**

CHILDREN

Please remember that this is an Agility Show, with a large number of dogs and visitors. Children must be under supervision at all times, and be aware of how to behave when around dogs. Dog handlers should also be aware that there will be children around the site and should take that into account with regards to their own dogs.

CUP CLASSES

The International Class, British Open, Nations Cup, Novice Cup and Starters Cup classes will take precedence. Please try and keep to your running orders in these classes. Please remember that if you qualify for any of the finals (including the International Young Handler), you must book in at the secretary's tent by the specified time in the schedule to be able to compete. You will also need your record book or proof of eligibility for the Starters and Novice Cup.

For the Nations Cup, overseas teams are put together when entering on your entry form. A list of the Home Nations competitors that have entered the British Open will be displayed in the Results marquee on the Thursday. Competitors are expected to tick against their name if they wish to be selected for the Nations Cup Team representing their country. Home Nations teams will be selected using the cumulative results of the British Open, as in previous years.

Ring Managers have been asked to restrict the number of dogs in a queue to a maximum of 10.

RESULTS

All rosettes will be presented as soon as possible after each class has finished. A board will be displayed next to the awards area detailing which classes have closed and which awards have been presented. If you miss your prize giving, the rosettes will be available from the unclaimed rosette area at the front of the secretary's tent, you will just need to tell the person in that area your surname. The results will be displayed in the awards tent next to the secretary's tent.

JUDGES' BRIEFINGS

There will be no briefings over the tannoy system. Standard Kennel Club marking will apply in all classes. The course times will be displayed next to the ring together with any additional notices the judge wishes you to be aware of.

PA RADIOS

Public Address announcements will be available to listen to on portable/car radios, the frequency is 87.7fm.

FRIDAY NIGHT DISCO

We will be holding a disco in the catering marquee from 08.00pm -10.30pm on Friday evening. Please bring a bottle and come and join in the fun. Catering stands and the beer bus will be open late.
