

Letchworth Premier Agility Show 2017 Information



CAMPING

Pitches are clearly marked. Please keep within the boundaries of your pitch and keep all roadways clear. All camping units must have a fire extinguisher or bucket of water which is accessible in the event of a fire. BBQ's may be used but never left unattended and must be raised off the ground to prevent scorching of the grass. Do not leave running generators unattended; please do not use generators between 9pm and 8am. All pitches must be vacated by 8.00pm Sunday evening. Please note that the area around the rings is out of bound after dark, for your own safety.

EXERCISE AREA

Please keep your dogs on a lead when walking around the area of the rings.

Our exercise area is the centre of the Racecourse, please cross the track at the designated points and stay on the matting DO NOT walk around the track itself or allow your dog on it. There is a lake at one end of the exercise area which is home to several pike, please DO NOT let your dogs swim in it.

Please do not ride bicycles in the exercise area.

The track by the road adjacent to the rings/camping area does NOT belong to the Racecourse, and is out of bound to the Show.

Please be considerate to others when exercising your dogs and keep them under control. We ask that you ALWAYS clear up after your dog. Bins/skips and black sacks are positioned around the venue for depositing your poo bags.
