GRADE 1 - 3

These classes are intended for dogs and handlers that are eligible for Grades 1 - 3 according to Kennel Club rules. Also dogs may jump one jump height lower for competition.

All dogs entering agility, jumping and special classes must have received appropriate agility training.

GRADE 4 - 7

These classes are intended for dogs and handlers that are eligible for Grades 4 - 7 according to Kennel Club rules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult when handling a dog
- Allsorts – no placings, clear round Rosettes available, for dogs/handlers new to agility or coming back after time off, no weaves or seesaw in these classes.
- First timer – for dogs over 15 months. Toys can be used although no food. Agility course to include hurdles, contacts and tunnels, no weaves or seesaw. No placings, clear round Rosettes available.
- Steeple Chase – a flowing jumping course without weaves
- Helter-skelter – a spiralling jumping course may have weaves
- Jumping – the following equipment could be used jumps, weaves, tyre, long jump
- Agility – as above for Jumping plus contact equipment such as dog walk, see-saw and A-Frame
- Also please note that these are a list of class numbers and not the sequence of classes at the show
- If entries for the Small and Medium (same grade) combined classes are less than 10 for each size on the day of the show, then the Small and Medium classes will be combined

1. All persons entering this show do so at their own risk. Whilst every care will be taken, Prestwood Agility and Training and the Owners of the showground will not accept any responsibility for loss, damage or injury caused to persons, dogs or property.
2. Prestwood Agility and Training reserve the right to refuse entries. The limit on entries will be 300 runs.
3. Entries being taken on a day space permitting.
4. Owners must sign the declaration on entry form. One entry form per handler please.
5. No bitches in season are allowed to compete and mating is forbidden on the showground.
6. Dogs that appear to be suffering with an infectious disease must be removed from the showground immediately.
7. You are responsible for cleaning up after all your dogs IN ALL AREAS please.
8. Dogs may wear a flat collar with a tag when competing. No special tags shall be worn in accordance with KC rules.
9. No training aides in the ring i.e. titbits/toys/bum bags except in Class 14 where a silent toy is permitted.
10. Marking of faults will be as per Kennel Club (KC) rules.
11. The Judge's decision is final.
12. No harsh handling either in the ring or exercise area. Any person found doing so will be asked to leave.
13. Judges may not run their own dogs for competition.
14. No puppies under 4 months allowed at the ringside.
15. In the unlikely event the show has to be cancelled Prestwood Pet Care, Prestwood Agility and Training reserve the right to defer expenses incurred by deducting any expenses occurred.
16. Any costs incurred for cheques returned will be met by the competitor.
17. Please respect our Judges/Ring Party at all times.
18. All competing dogs must be over 18 months of age except in the First timer class where they must be over 15 months.
19. There will be no refunds after the closing date.
20. There will be no running orders sent out.
21. Jump heights will be 650mm for Large dogs, 450mm for Medium dogs, 350mm for Small dogs, Lower Height Option for Large dogs 550mm. Lower height option will run first. Jump heights for Allsorts will be 450 mms; 350 mm and 250 mm. In the Allsorts you can elect to run your dog at any height.
22. Equipment to be used is Doggy Jumps, plastic jumps, contacts are aluminium with rubber surface.
23. Dogs to be kept on the lead at all times, except when competing in one of the agility rings.
24. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the agility rings. (see Rule 9)
25. Welfare of dogs – any exhibitor or competitor whose dog is entered at this event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dog(s) health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise.
26. Dogs are not to be left in cars during hot weather or standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.
27. Cheques made payable to Prestwood Agility and Flyball.
28. Please note that the show will have one indoor arena and one outdoor arena..
