Thank you for your entries to our show. Please remember whilst competing with us over the weekend, that Agility is supposed to be a fun event – so enjoy what you achieve with your dogs and remember who trained them!

Briefings will be at 8.45am with judging immediately after (9am) on all rings each day

You will find overleaf the ring plan for both days.

Showground Entry Day Parking

Entry to the showground for all agility competitors will **ONLY** be via the South Gate where the MDS show security will be located. After proceeding through the South gate, follow signs for AGILITY SHOW TRAFFIC. Passes will be exchanged for wristbands for the day of the show you are competing. There will be marshals and security on the car park gate at all times so ensure you take your passes with you to get back into the car park.

No cars will be allowed movement internally around the venue past 9.00am each show

morning – after the issues we had with vehicular movement around the camping area surrounding the rings it must be understood for everyone's benefit (and the competing dogs) that there will be **NO vehicular movement** internally around the agility section whilst competition is in progress.

Help on Rings

Thank you to those of you that have already kindly offered to help us on the rings. Everyone who does help sufficiently on the rings will be given a packed lunch AND a helpers T Shirt – so please a little help will go a long way. Also, for those of you that have indicated on your entry forms that you are willing to aid us with ring party help and are day parking you have a special day pass to get your vehicles closer to the rings than the day parking area.

KC Measuring

Please come to the secretary's marquee to book your appointment on the morning and please remember, if this is your first show you require measuring before competing.

Public Event.

Please remember this is an open public event and as such we would ask that your behaviour to others and their dogs are a credit to our sport. As such, may we remind you that **No Person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of any animal.**

Dogs in Hot Weather

We are unsure of what the weather will hold for us (please let it be nice!) BUT remember it is your own responsibility to ensure all dogs entered in the agility show (competing or NFC) should NOT be kept in hot vehicles! Please remember to give dogs a means of shade and have constant means of liquid hydration. If dogs are reported / found in hot cars we will have no hesitation in breaking windows to get the dogs out and report the persons & incident to the Kennel Club.

CAMPING INFORMATION

Agility Campers will be camped from 2pm on FRIDAY (and not before)

All units and vehicles must be parked within the four corners of your camping pitch.

No two units will be permitted to be joined together and we MUST ensure clear emergency vehicular access around all units – so NO parking will be permitted in the road ways.

Each unit should have a means of extinguishing a fire or a bucket of water outside their unit.

No camping vehicles will be allowed into the camping area after 8.30am on show days due to the limitation applied to vehicular movement. MDS gates will be closed at 8pm so if you are caught in traffic and not going to arrive until after this time, Linda's mobile number is **07920 047486**. Please let us know and the club will do all we can to make arrangements to meet you – however if your arrival time is very late you will be parked up in a holding area until the following morning.

Please note that there will be round the clock security on the gates from Thursday evening to Monday morning.

If you are camping with us you need to be aware of the following MDS - Paws in the Park show organiser's rules which are:

- Dog owners / handlers should clean up after their dogs. The safety and wellbeing of all animals at the show remains the responsibility of the exhibitor / owner. This includes provision of shade, shelter and water as required.
- Dogs **MUST** be on a lead at all times around the rings unless competing in a ring.
- Dogs must be on lead within the camping areas – dogs only to be off lead in the exercise areas.
- **No Generators are allowed on site.**
- Skips – please place your rubbish **IN** the skips provided and **DO NOT** leave bags laying around the bottom of the skips. We would appreciate your help to keep this much used agility show venue tidy.
- Chemical toilets are ONLY to be emptied on the showground where directed. DO NOT empty into any temporary show toilet units.
- No driving is permitted around campsite unless necessary.
- Strictly NO FIREWORKS
- No quads, Go-Peds, Go Karts or other non-road legal forms of transport. Disabled mobility devices are allowed. If you have any special requirements you should notify show secretary or MDS staff.
- No open fires allowed or floor level barbeques – and ensure all ash / charcoal been left overnight before putting in skips – I don't want another fire like we have had in the past in a skip !!
- No cutting down or damaging of any trees or shrubbery
- No excessive noise after 10pm.
- ***Be nice to the camping marshals !***
