

Welcome to our 2019 championship show. Please note that the championship ring will start at 8.30 am on Saturday. Medium Championship will start at 9 am on Sunday and Small Championship will start at 9.30 am. If you think that your Small & Medium champ runs will clash then please talk to the ring party before the classes start.

We have had to make changes to our judges and classes both days as shown on the ringplans. Firstly thanks to Ian Spreadbury for agreeing to judge for us and then agreeing to stand down as entry numbers showed that we didn't need our planned extra ring on the Sunday. Changes on Saturday are Class 3 Large Graded 1-2 Jumping will now be judged by Paul Smith, Class 12 Medium Graded 1-2 Jumping by Anne Edwards, Class 18 Small Graded 1-2 Jumping by Lin Bergan. Changes on Sunday are Class 37 Medium Graded 3-4 Jumping, Class 38 Medium Graded 5-6 Jumping, Class 44 Small Graded 3-4 Jumping, Class 45 Small Graded 5-6 Jumping will now be judged by Rosie Dains, Class 26 Large Combined 1-3 Jumping Part 2 FH by Grace Blackmore, Class 48 Veteran Special 1-7 Agility by Iain Patz.

We are having live electronic scoring on laptops and the progress of classes and results will be available to view either on your phone or in the marquee at www.agilityaid.co.uk/results

Thank you to everyone that has volunteered to help as this is always needed and we couldn't run the show without you. Please report to your ring before judging starts to let them know when you can help. We haven't needed everyone even on the Sunday but please respond if we do call out for help over the PA. Breakfast vouchers will be available from the marquee and lunch vouchers from your ring manager. There will be a helpers' raffle both days this year. You will be given a wristband to hand in with your name on. Prizes each day will be 1st place – Free camping for 2020 and 2nd place – Free individual entries for 1 dog for 2020.

Please respect and be nice to our ring parties and judges as they have volunteered so that you can enjoy the show. We want them to enjoy it too!

Campers please enter via Princes Gate. There is a new layout this year with thanks to Jonathan Hallam at Woodhall Mapping Solutions. Camping is allocated so please ensure that you know your pitch number and the rough location from the plan. Anyone incorrectly camped will be asked to move. All day parkers will come in through the South Gate. There will be parking nearer the rings for helpers. Tunbridge Wells breed show will take place in or near the Abergavenny building on the Saturday. Please do not allow your dogs to encroach on their area. Their parking will be through the first gate coming from the north. Please do not get confused by signs there.

Lunch time will be between 12.30pm – 1.30pm approx on both days.

A Raffle will be run on Saturday in aid of Many Tears Rescue, Children's Hospice South West (Little Harbour) as chosen by our Small & Medium champ judges.

There will be no PA before 9 am so briefings will be at the rings. Please make sure that you get to the rings promptly if you have an early running order. PA announcements will be going out on the radio. The frequency should be 87.7 FM

If you bring children/teenagers to the show, please remember they are your responsibility at all times. Children to be under parental supervision at all times. Any damage caused will have to be paid for.

Dogs are not allowed in the pond. Please keep them and children safely away from it.

Please pick up after your dogs everywhere including on the cross country course.

Only gas barbecues are allowed.

Please site generators to avoid disturbance for neighbours and turn off by 9pm.

Tunbridge Wells 2019 Site Layout

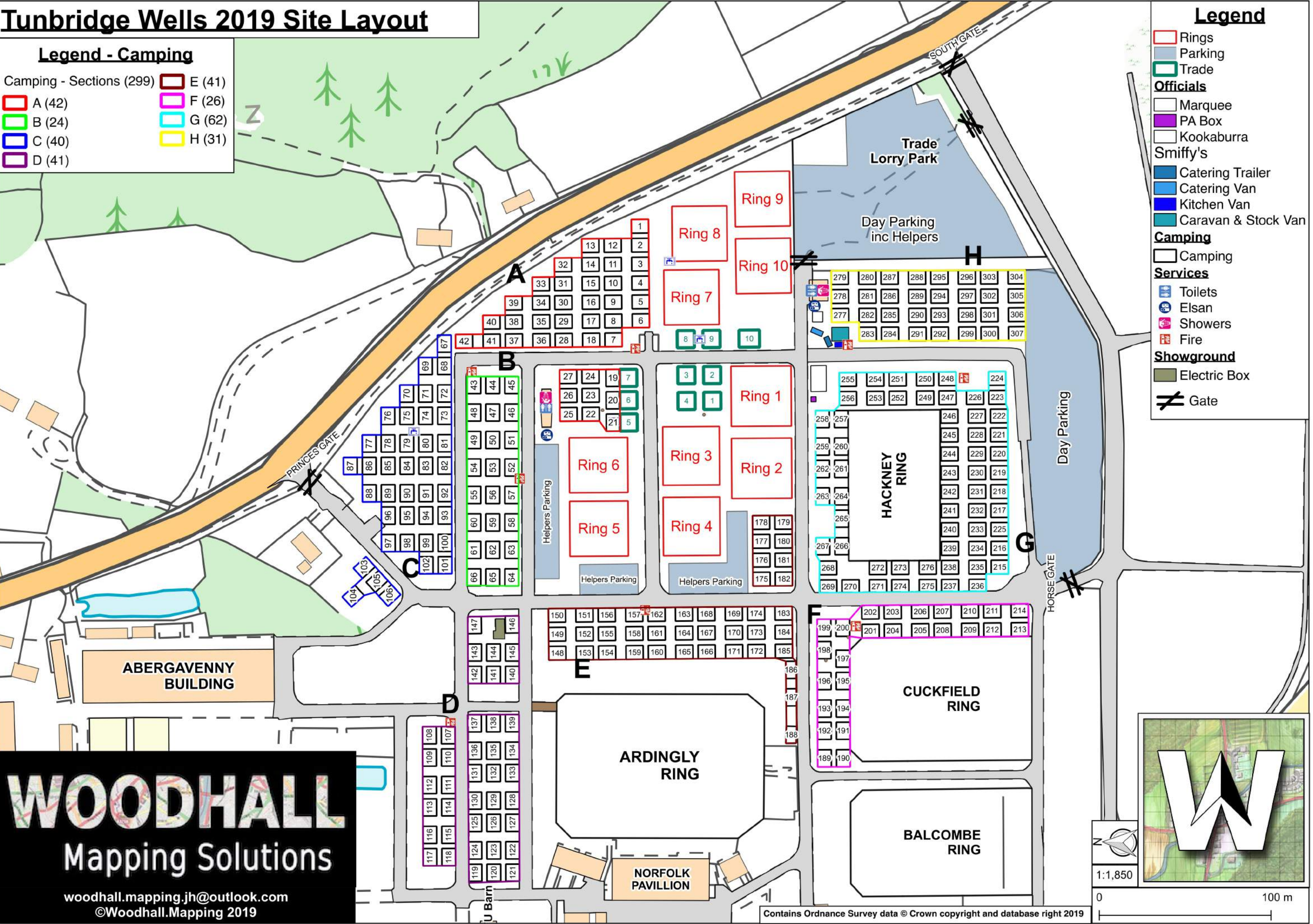
