Parking

STRICTLY 5mph - Day parkers please follow directions from our parking officials

Do not park in the vacant fields on the entrance side of the hedge tempting as it may be to make use of the shade in that area! We have not rented that ground - use of that area could impose additional costs to the club and we will pass these charges on to those parked illegally.

Camping

No arrivals before 4.00pm Friday, caravans to depart no later than 10.00am Monday - Gate will be locked from 9pm onwards - contact secretary for gate code if needed. Camping pitches will be allocated on arrival, please park in your designated site. Do not block the spaces between camping units - emergency vehicles must have access. Please ensure that you have a bucket of water or a fire extinguisher in case of fire. You will be issued with a black bin liner - please make use of this. All rubbish to be collected up and put into the large skip beside the Barn before vacating the show ground. It would be a help if you could return your site cone number to the Barn as well.

Measuring

MEASURING FROM 12noon at the back of the Barn

Book in at the secretary's table in the Barn on the morning of the show. The measurers are Marie Hembrow and Lesley Olden. Agility Record Books will be available for purchasing at £1.50 each. Please remember to bring your dog's official registration document. All dogs will need to be identified and matched to their paperwork by their microchip number. Measuring will cost £4.

Dogs In Hot Cars

DON'T COOK YOUR DOGS!

Even overcast and slightly hot days raise the temperature inside a vehicle so please make sure that it is shaded and aired at all times. Also make sure that your dogs have fresh cold water at all times, and please return to your vehicle regularly to check on your dogs. **If necessary, we will use force, without liability, to remove any animal in distress from your vehicle.**

Exercise Area

NO DOG OFF LEAD in the camping site, the day parking and the area in which the rings are constructed (except under test conditions).

Dogs may be exercised off lead in the remaining show grounds, subject to their owner/handler picking up after their dogs and depositing dog waste in the bins that are in various locations across the grounds. You may walk your dogs in the woods where there is a stream they might like to cool off in.
