## **Allocation of Trophies & Rosettes**

1 - 30 in a class 1st place only will be awarded. 31 - 60 in a class 1st & 2nd will be awarded  
61 + in a class and 1st - 3rd will be awarded.

### **ENTERED AGILITY DOG HANDLER GETS FREE ENTRY TO PAWS IN THE PARK EVENT**

This wording has caused some confusion over past years but it is the main MDS event organisers intention that those people handling an agility dog in the show or registered as a joint owner will be given a free pass to the event. Therefore, individual competitors with a running order which details them as handler/owner will be permitted into the Paws in the Park event at no additional charge. This offer is not intended however for people to list a person as a handler and then change it on the day just to get an entrance pass! Any additional family members, friends etc in a vehicle will be charged at the full price on day of arrival UNLESS they have purchased a pre booked ticket with their agility entries at a REDUCED PRICE as detailed below: Please note if you are an owner in joint names you will need to ensure you detail that to get an additional entrance ticket and ownership records may be checked with the KC.

Adult: Agility offer price of £8 per ticket  
Child/OAP: Agility offer price of £6 per ticket  
Family of - 2 Adults & 2 children: Agility offer price of £26

**Please note that only 1 free pass will be sent per competing handler/joint owner in line with the above, unless otherwise agreed and arranged with the show organiser.**

**Please note the price of posting has been increased to cover first class postage of R/O's due to the sending out of entrance tickets**

### **Official KC Measuring**

All small & medium dogs must be officially measured before competing at a licensed KC show. We shall have the availability for dogs to be measured at our show. Please contact Linda on info@petlodge.co.uk if you will need a dog measured so your name can be added to the list.

### **Campers Evening Entertainment**

On Friday and Saturday evenings there will some evening entertainment laid on by the main show event organisers. Entry is FREE to all Campers and Traders staying on site where there will be a selection of hot food stalls available and a bar.

### **SPECIAL CLASSES**

**Allsorts Class** – This class is for those dogs not entered in any other class in the show on either day. Competitors can choose which height they wish to jump at – 45cm, 35cm or micro.

This class is intended for those dogs that are still fit and able to do agility or for the young dog who is seeking experience in the ring.

# The Animal Health Company Classic Competition Rules 2019



A Dog Agility competition for small, medium and large standard size dogs 3 – 6 combined grades using a Steeplechase style course. The class must be judged using current Kennel Club rules and a course must feature the Westcotts Water Jump.

**Class Title** The Animal Health Company Classic 3 – 6 Combined Grades Special

**Class Style** Spectator attractive steeplechase course with jumps and tunnels (No weaves or contact equipment) and **MUST** contain the Westcotts Water Jump. We encourage the use of walls, well, brush fences etc. Judges be creative!

**Class rules:** Each dog must run at its correct height under KC rules. The Show / Judge may chose which height to start at and once the height has been altered to the next height it is up to the judge if they accommodate a request from a competitor to jump a previous height. Judges decision is final at heats. This is one class: Small, Medium and Large dogs are competing against each other for one set of awards in one class and walk the course all together.

**Qualifiers:** Each host venue provides 5 winning partnerships to take to the final. No reserves are needed. Host clubs are invited to check with your winners and If already qualified take the next placed dog to provide your 5 qualifiers. See note 4.

The Animal Health Company Classic Final details will be announced shortly

## Notes

- 1) The Water Jump height should be set at large dogs compete at 450mm, medium dogs 350mm and small at 200mm height and the water tray contains water to assist the judging of the obstacle.
- 2) Handlers can qualify any number of dogs for the final that will run in draw order.
- 3) Any surrogate handlers must be notified in writing within 4 days of the last heat. NO amendments after this date and non-advice will disqualify the partnership.
- 4) Only partnerships notified by organisers at each heat will be invited to the final. Show organisers may take other places if any of the first five dogs has already qualified at a previous heat.
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to withdraw invitation to the final.
- 6) The Final will be run in size order, the organiser reserves the right to decided what height order the final will run in.
- 7) The warm up event maybe a semi final subject to attendance.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

A maximum of four standard classes may be scheduled for any dog on an individual day of competition. Any number of special classes may be scheduled.

**Class Structure.** A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H(1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.

Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

**Lower Height Option.** Societies may offer the Lower Height Option to all dogs in that height category and may be offered at all grades. It is to be run as part of any Standard class as defined in the regulations and must be clearly identified in the schedule. Each relevant class will have two heights with a change part way through to raise/lower the jump heights and may extend/reduce the length of the long jump and width of the rising spread, within the permitted ranges, and competitors must run at their entered height. The order in which the heights will run must be detailed on the ring cards/ring plan. There will be only one course walking at the start of the class. In a class where the Lower Height Option is available show organisers may offer one set of awards by combining the results of each height or may offer separate awards for each height category.

Competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins. Hurdles may be raised/lowered during the course walking time if multiple heights are offered within the same class.

When the Lower Height Option is scheduled a dog may only be entered at either the Full Height or the Lower Height and it cannot compete at a different height in any other class at that competition, including special classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule.

**Points Progression.** At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

### **STANDARD CLASSES**

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

#### **Grade 1**

Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

#### **Grade 2**

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

#### **Grade 3**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

#### **Grade 4**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7

#### **Grade 5**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7

#### **Grade 6**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

#### **Grade 7**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

### **SPECIAL CLASSES**

Societies may schedule classes other than those defined above as "Special classes". The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class. Where special classes are classified for older and/or inexperienced dogs, the height of the hurdles, the A-ramp, and the dog walk, and the length of the long jump, may be reduced below the dimensions specified in these regulations, in which case such dimensions must be included in the class definition in the show schedule.

Marking for special classes may deviate from marking for standard classes, but must be specified in the schedule. Wins, places and clear rounds in special classes will not count towards agility warrant points or grade progression at Kennel Club shows.

*In case of cancellation of the show within seven days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant web sites and posted on applicable facebook groups where possible. It will be the competitor's responsibility to check with these services if continuation of the show is in doubt.*

# **NOW THE BORING BITS BUT YOU MUST BE AWARE OF THEM!**

## **Rules and Regulations**

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/ authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry fees will be £3.50 per dog per class for non members and £2.00 per class for members of Whitstable Agility Group. Camping is £25 per unit.
4. There will be no prize money in any class.
5. Internet entries will be accepted via: [www.agilityshows.online](http://www.agilityshows.online)
6. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
9. No classes will be capped.
10. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
11. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
12. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
13. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
14. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
15. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
16. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
17. Sponsorship: Animal Health Classic are providing trophies and rosettes for class 68
18. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply for all standard classes.
19. Allsorts classes Jump Heights – at the handler's choice of 45cm, 35cm or micro
20. The Height limit for dogs:
  - a. Large Dogs For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
  - b. Medium Dogs For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
  - c. Small Dogs For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
21. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
22. Removal of dogs from competition. Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the show if it is :
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition / show Incident Book and submitted to the Kennel Club.
23. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
24. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (20<sup>th</sup> August 2019) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to **notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show** (30<sup>th</sup> August 2019). The dog should then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
25. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
26. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event the society will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
27. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
28. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
29. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
30. Free passes - All competitors will be provided with a free pass enabling them to enter the event at any time of the day their competition is scheduled, but in the case of a dog owned in partnership passes will be issued to both parties. Reduced price entry tickets for others attending show with agility competitors can be purchased via show secretary. in the case of more than one handler running the same dog only one pass will be issued.
31. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.

32. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
33. Animals in Event - No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Board. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
34. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
35. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring will be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
36. Welfare of Dogs - An owner (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog is met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Kennel Club Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.
37. The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
38. Any exhibitor forwarding a cheque which is returned by the bank will be charged an additional £10 to cover bank and administration charges before the entry is accepted.
39. Overpaid fees will not be refunded.
40. Entries will only be accepted with payment by cheque, postal order or cash in sterling. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
41. Your attention is drawn to Kennel Club rule F8(A) regarding dog fouling. "Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including the car and caravan parks and the show approaches".
42. All dogs are entered at their owners' risk.
43. Campers must remain within their allocated space and MUST NOT obstruct the roadways. Joining of gardens is not allowed. All units must be equipped with a fire extinguishers and/or bucket of water at the tow bar.
44. Training equipment must not be used in or near any camping or parking areas.
45. The dog's signed Agility Record Book must be available for inspection by the Show Management and/or the Judge on the date of any competition entered by the owner/handler.
46. If a refund is requested by a competitor- A) Any entries that have been received and processed, then cancelled before the closing date of the show will be refunded with a deduction of the processing costs per entry plus £1.50 to cover the cost of postage and bank charges for cashing and issuing the refund. B) After the closing date, no refunds will be given.
47. No unclaimed rosettes will be posted unless a SAE is provided by competitor.

NOTE: Children under the age of 11 are the responsibility of a Parent or Guardian and must be supervised at all times including when competing.

**Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm, so please take care of your dog.**

**If however, your dog is found to be at risk then forcible entry to your vehicle may be deemed necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**STRICT 5mph (that's miles per hour!) will be in force in all the agility areas – that is on all internal roads and in the camping area.**

**No excuse will be acceptable for this site rule to be broken.**

**We really don't want to refuse your entries next year, however, if we find a speeding car is associated to an agility person we will have no option!!!!**
