Awards

Prizes for 1st place & placed rosettes to 10%
Anysize/Veterans classes will place 1st – 5th (combined heights)

Eligibility

Large:	For dogs measuring over 500mm at the withers.
Intermediate:	For dogs measuring over 430mm and measuring 500mm or under at the withers.
Medium:	For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers.
Small:	For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.

Dogs grades will be in line with Kennel Club grading:

Grade 1

Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 3

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7

Grade 5

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7

Grade 6

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

Helter Skelter: A jumping course usually set in increasing or decreasing circles.

Steeplechase: A flowing jumping course consisting of hurdles and pipe tunnels only.

Veterans Classes: These classes are open to dogs not entered in any other class at this show (except other Veteran classes). They will be simple, flowing courses for dogs aged 8 years and over. Hurdle heights will be: 400mm, 300mm and 200mm. You may enter your dog at whichever jump height you wish regardless of your dogs size. No weaves, tyre or long jump will be used in these classes.

Anysize Classes: These classes are open to dogs not entered in any other class at this show (except other Anysize classes). They will be simple, flowing courses particularly suitable for inexperienced dogs or handlers, and those dogs that are unable to compete at their full height. Hurdle heights will be: 400mm, 300mm and 200mm. You may enter your dog at whichever jump height you wish regardless of your dogs size. No weaves, tyre or long jump will be used in these classes.

All dogs entered into the show must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.

Children under the age of 11 are the responsibility of a Parent or Guardian and must be supervised at all times including when competing.

Camping to include Friday and Saturday nights. No arrivals before 3pm Friday and everyone off the field by 7pm Sunday. Units must have a means to extinguish fire available at all times.



We will be holding a charity raffle at the show and we'll also be collecting items suitable for dog rescues, if you have any items you wish to donate please bring them along to the show, they will be gratefully received.

Rules & Regulations

1. All dogs entered for competition must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
2. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete.
3. The management reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Entry fees will be £3.50 per dog per class, £3.00 Anysize/Veterans, Camping £25.00, pay on the day entries £4.50.
5. Internet entries will be accepted at: www.agilityshows.online
6. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
7. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
8. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
9. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
10. The management reserve the right to combined/split classes depending on the number of entries.
11. Should circumstances so dictate the management may alter arrangements as necessary.
12. In the event of abandonment of the show, the management will defray any such expenses from received fees to cover the cost of the show preparation and any non-retrievable expenses before issuing refunds.
13. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
14. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
15. No dog/s suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the show or which is suffering from a condition which adversely affects its health or welfare may compete.
16. It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible.
17. Returned cheques will incur a £10 fee to the competitor to cover bank and administration charges before the entry is accepted.
18. Overpayment will not be refunded.
19. Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s.
20. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
21. If you choose to download your ring cards you are agreeing for the information on them to be publicly viewable online.
22. The show organisers or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.
