If you enter 'Allsorts' you can only enter the other classes NFC (Not For Competition i.e. you are not eligible for a trophy / rosette) There will be no running orders sent out (unless entering through www.agilityaid.co.uk). Running orders will be posted on Facebook around one week before the show. We need help on the day to run the show (no previous experience needed!). If you can help for a couple of hours you will get refreshments as a thank you!

Useful Information and Rules

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult when handling a dog. Allsorts – For dogs or handlers new to agility/coming back after time off or veteran dogs. No weaves or seesaw in these classes. For dogs over 15 months. Toys can be used but no food. Steeple Chase – A flowing jumping course will have tunnel(s) without weaves. Helter-skelter – A spiralling jumping course may have weaves and / or tunnel(s) Jumping – The following equipment could be used jumps, tunnel, weaves, long jump. Agility – As above for Jumping plus contact equipment such as dog walk, see-saw and A-Frame. Power and speed – A two part course. One part with contact equipment and weaves. The other part has jumps and may have tunnel(s). You must get a clear round in the first part to proceed to the second part. The judge will signal any faults in the first part. All classes can be entered as NFC (not for competition). Clear round rosettes will be given. Allsorts will be run as one class however the results will be split between new handlers/ dogs and veterans/experienced handlers (to include dogs coming back from injury), please note which section on entry form/at ringside. Allsorts heights will be 200, 300, 400, 500. Dogs can be run at any height. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> All persons entering this show do so at their own risk. Whilst every care will be taken, Prestwood Agility and Training and the Owners of the showground will not accept any responsibility for loss, damage or injury caused to persons, dogs or property. Prestwood Agility and Training reserve the right to refuse entries. The limit on entries will be 400 runs. Each dog can only enter a maximum of 6 classes (including NFC classes). Online closing date is the last day in the previous month. Owners must sign the declaration on entry form. One entry form per handler. No bitches in season are allowed to compete and mating is forbidden on the showground. Dogs that appear to be suffering with an infectious disease must be removed from the showground immediately. You are responsible for cleaning up after all your dogs IN ALL AREAS please. Dogs may wear a flat collar with a tag when competing. No special tags shall be worn in accordance with KC rules. No training aides in the ring i.e. tibbits/toys/bum bags except in Allsorts Classes where a silent toy is permitted. Marking of faults will be as per KC rules. The Judge's decision is final. This schedule forms part of the rules. No harsh handling either in the ring or exercise area. Any person found doing so will be asked to leave. Judges may not run their own dogs for competition. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> No puppies under 4 months allowed at the ringside. In the unlikely event the show has to be cancelled Prestwood Pet Care, Prestwood Agility and Training reserve the right to defer expenses incurred by deducting any expenses occurred. Any costs incurred for cheques returned will be met by the competitor. Please respect our Judges/Ring Party at all times. All competing dogs must be over 18 months of age except in the Allsorts class where they must be over 15 months. There will be no refunds after the online closing date. There will be no running orders sent out (unless entering through www.agilityaid.co.uk). Running orders will be posted on Facebook around one week prior to show. Jump heights will be 600mm for Large dogs, 500mm for Intermediate dogs, 400mm for Medium dogs, 300mm for Small dogs. (Please note there is no longer a LHO option). Jump heights for Allsorts will be 500mm; 400mm; 300mm and 200mm. In the Allsorts you can elect to run your dog at any height. Dogs, must run in accordance with their KC Height and Grade (large over 500mm; Intermediate over 430mm and up to 500mm; Medium over 350mm and up to 430mm; Small 350mm and below). Equipment to be used is Doggy Jumps, plastic jumps, contacts are aluminium with rubber surface. Dogs to be kept on the lead at all times, except when competing in one of the agility rings. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the agility rings. (see Rule 9) Welfare of dogs – any exhibitor or competitor whose dog is entered at this event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dog(s) health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. No retractable leads to be used around or in the rings.
