Triple A

The only contact obstacle will be the A Frame which you will need to negotiate 3 times

Double Dog Walk

The only contact obstacle will be the Dog Walk which you will need to negotiate 2 times.

Up & Under

Jumping course consisting of jumps & tunnels.

Steeplechase

A fast flowing jumping course.

Eligibility

Elementary	All those beginner dogs regardless of handler - KC Grade 1 dogs
Starters	KC Grade 2/3 dogs
Novice	KC Grades 4/5
Senior	KC Grades 6/7
Veteran	Dogs 7 years and over
Anysize	For dogs that do not fit anywhere else
Juniors	Handlers 18 years and under
	May enter a maximum of 4 runs each day per dog

Veteran & Anysize

Will have a choice of jump heights 40cm – 30cm – 20cm (but not above their measured height) there will be no weaves or seesaw in these classes and the Dogwalk and A-Frame will be lowered.

Anysize may carry a silent toy in the ring for competition – all others carrying a silent toy in the ring will be NFC.

Dog Size Categories

<u>Micro</u>	For dogs under 35cm (~13in) at the withers, jump height 20cm
<u>Small</u>	For dogs under 35cm (~13in) at the withers, jump height 30cm
<u>Medium</u>	For dogs over 35cm (~13in) & under 43cm (~17in) at the withers, jump height 40cm
<u>Intermediate</u>	For dogs 43cm (~17in) & under 50cm (~19.6in) at the withers, jump height 50cm
<u>Large</u>	For dogs 50cm (~19.6in) or over at at the withers, jump height 60cm

Dogs may only be entered in one size category for the duration of the show. The jump heights have been chosen to provide choice for handlers who compete between multiple organizations and remain sympathetic towards the pet dog.

A dog measuring under 35cm has the choice of running as **Micro or Small**

A dog measuring under 43cm has the choice of running **Small or Medium**

A dog measuring between 43cm and 50cm has the choice of running **Medium or Intermediate**

A dog measuring over 50cm has the choice of running **Intermediate or Large**

All dogs entered into the show must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner. Standard KC marking will apply (up contacts will not be marked).

All Rings will be fenced

All dogs entered into the show must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner. Standard KC marking will apply (up contacts will not be marked)

Placed rosettes to 3rd in each class

Clear round rosettes in all classes which must be collected on the day of the show

There will be hot food and beverages

CAMPING

Is available for a fee of £10 per night with arrivals welcome after 2pm on Friday 27th May. No arrivals after 8pm without prior agreement. Please park where directed.

All units must carry a fire extinguisher or have a bucket of water at the front of the unit.

Toilets are available

Show Rules and Regulations

- 01 All dogs entered for competition must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
- 02 Entry fees: £3.50 per dog per class - £4.50 POTD.
- 03 Internet entries will be accepted via www.agilityaid.co.uk
- 04 The Management reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 05 Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete
- 06 No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show
- 07 Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring
- 08 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
- 09 Withdrawal of dogs from competition
 - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious/contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any other person or animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
10. We reserve the right to combine/split classes dependant on entries
11. Should circumstances so dictate, the Management may alter arrangements as necessary
12. In the event of abandonment of the show, the Management will defray any such expenses from received fees to cover the cost of the show preparation and any non-retrievable expenses before issuing refunds
13. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring. Handlers in any size and elementary classes may use a silent toy in the ring. If using toys in elementary the toy must not be thrown and the run will be NFC. Squeaky toys, clickers and whistles must not be used in the vicinity of the rings. At the judges discretion you may ask for help from a third party i.e. holding a dog on the start line but at no time should there be more than one handler in the ring.
14. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his Authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees
15. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the competition or which is suffering from a condition which adversely affects its health or welfare may compete.
16. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible
17. Any exhibitor forwarding a cheque which is returned by the bank will be charged an additional £10 to cover bank and administration charges before the entry is accepted
18. Overpaid fees will not be refunded
19. All dogs are entered at their owners' risk. Whilst every care will be taken, the Management will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or property
20. Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dogs.
21. If you choose to download your ring cards you are agreeing for the information on them to be publicly viewable online
22. Coldham Agility or their authorised agents may make results from this show publicly available and share results with third parties for the same purpose.

COVID

The organisers will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) – in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the organisers discretion. If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must isolate in line with Government advice – www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do. The competitor must not attend the event.

It is planned to hold this show under the government guidelines in force at the time of the event, however the club reserves the right to impose any restrictions they feel are required to ensure the safety of all involved.
